

## "The most common mistakes made by Spanish learners"

Learning Spanish is an exciting journey, but like any language, it comes with its own set of challenges. In this list, we've gathered 16 common mistakes that many learners make when studying Spanish. | Mistake                      | Correct word       | Explanation  |
|------------------------------|--------------------|--|
| 1. La problema               | El problema        | Most nouns ending in -ma, -pa, -ta (Greek origin) are masculine. |
| 2. La sistema                | El sistema         | Same as above  |
| 3. Una tema                  | Un tema            | Same pattern; tema is masculine                                  |
| 4. El mano: hand             | La mano            | Mano is an exception—it's feminine.                              |
| 5. El foto                   | La foto            | Short for la fotografía, which is feminine.                      |
| 6. La sofá                   | El sofá            | Sofá is masculine.   |
| 7. El leche (milk)           | La leche           | Leche is feminine  |
| 8. La mapa                   | El mapa            | Mapa is masculine despite ending in -a                           |
| 9. El mente Viejo (old mind) | La mente vieja.    | Mente is feminine; adjectives must match in gender and number.   |
| 10. La programa              | El programa        | From Greek origin; masculine noun.                               |
| 11. los dos personas         | Las dos personas   | Personas is feminine and plural.                                 |
| 12. El lección               | La lección         | Lección is feminine.   |
| 13. No problema              | No hay problema.   | Spanish needs a verb—hay = there is/are                          |
| 14. No podemos hoy           | No podemos hoy.    | Correct conjugation of poder in present tense.                   |
| 15. un Fiesta pequeño        | Una fiesta pequeña | Fiesta is feminine; adjective must agree.                        |
| 16. Fácil                    | Fácil              | Needs accent mark (tilde) on the "a"                             |
